


Using Medianet Resources to support Common Core Standards

Note the different format types that are available: Audio Books on CD, Classroom Book Collection, Playaway, CCCD, Curriculum Kit, Multi-Media Kit, Big Book, Digital Audio, Jackdaw, etc. (“A Jackdaw is your personal archive of hands-on primary source materials. They are an array of fascinating, relevant primary source documents delivered directly to you. Most documents are reproduced in their actual sizes for you to touch and explore over and over. Transcripts and translations of difficult to read documents are provided for better understanding. Jackdaw primary sources encourage critical thinking and analysis, and augment retention of information in a variety of interdisciplinary disciplines” <http://www.jackdaw.com/t-jackdaws.aspx>).

- Select a format type, and an audience level and click **Submit** to see all format types that are available for your audience level. For example, select CCCD (Coordinated Cooperative Collection Development) and Primary (Grades K-3) and click **Submit**. The following screen appears:

Note that many of the titles have a paper clip. The paper clip indicates that a photograph of the kit is included.

- Click **Adirondacks in Fact and Fiction: Plant life** and note the synopsis and NYS Learning Standards that are included with each kit.
- Click on the thumbnail to see a larger picture of the resources in the kit. Close the photo window.
- Click the **Search** tab to return to the Media Catalog Search screen.
- Enter one or more words in the search box to look for subjects and topics that you'd like.
- To reserve something, click on **Add to my list**.
